



MILITARY ORDER OF THE PURPLE HEART

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

Amount: One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00 or \$500.00)

To be awarded during the respective school's ceremony.

To be eligible for a Military Order of the Purple Heart scholarship, the student must be:

- a United States citizen,

and
- the direct descendant (child, step-child, adopted child, grandchild or great grandchild) of a Veteran who served honorably in one of the military branches of the United States Armed Service (Army, Navy, Marine Corps., Air Force or Coast Guard),

and
- an upcoming graduate (Senior) of an accredited high school, with proof of enrollment as a full-time student (12 or more semester credit hours, or 18 quarter credit hours) at a Community College, State College, University or Trade School at the time the scholarship is awarded,

and
- a full-time student with at least a 2.5 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) based on a 4.0 grading system, and a financial need.

The student is to complete and sign the upper part of the attached application and submit a one page typed essay titled "What a Veteran means to me".

The student's Counselor or school Administrator is to complete and sign the bottom half of the attached application and return it to the below named Scholarship Chairman or direct the student to do so.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE NO LATER THAN MAY 4th, 2018

ATTENTION: FUNDS WILL BE SENT TO SCHOOL UPON PROOF OF ATTENDANCE. STUDENT'S SHALL SUBMIT A LETTER FROM OFFICE OF REGISTRAR, ADMISSIONS OFFICE OR COUNSELOR.
